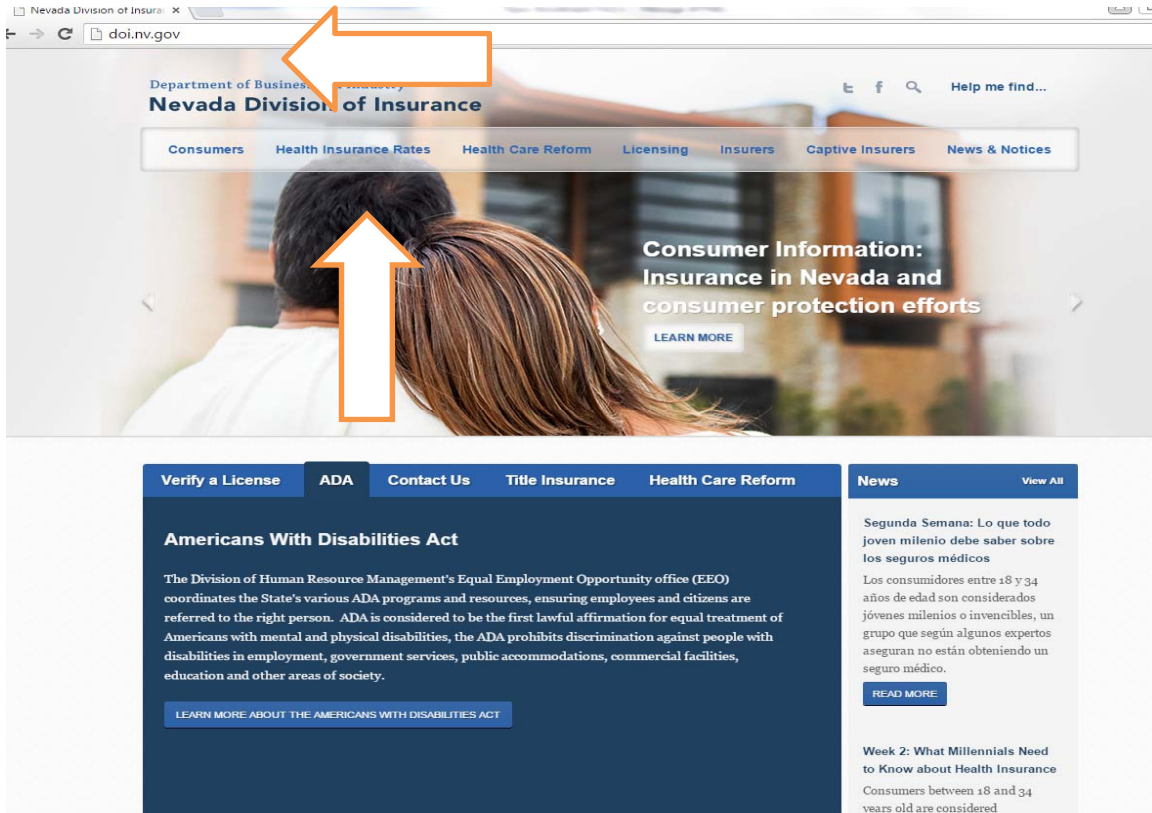
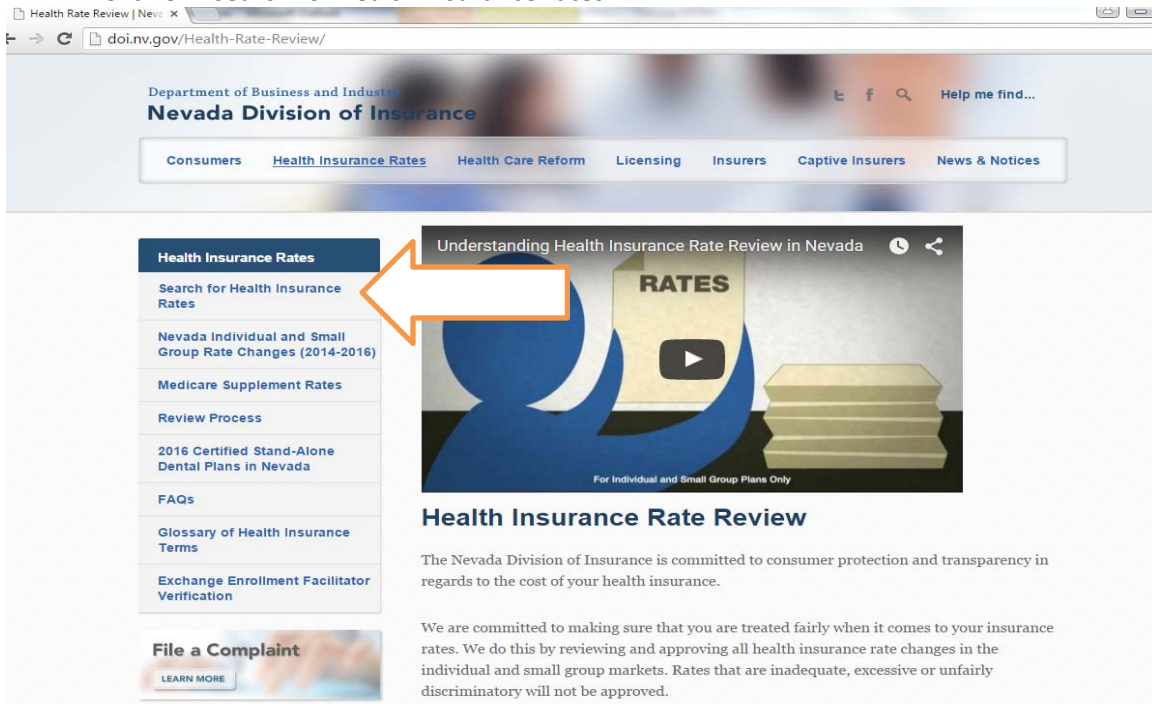

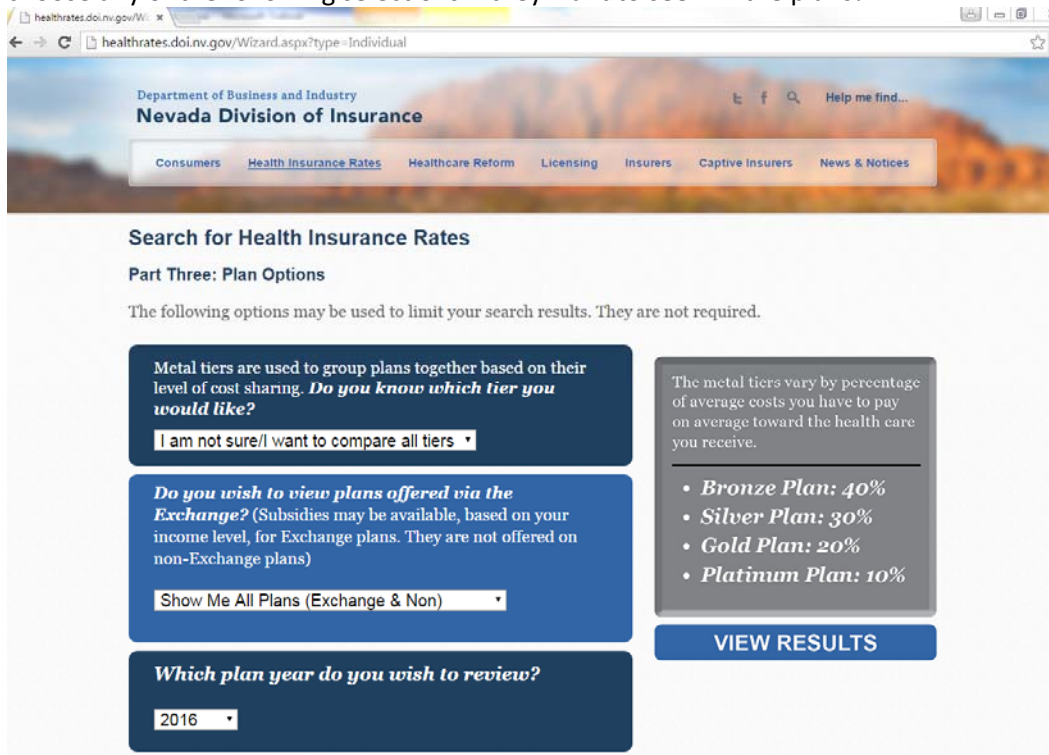
1. Visit doi.nv.gov then click on Health Insurance Rates



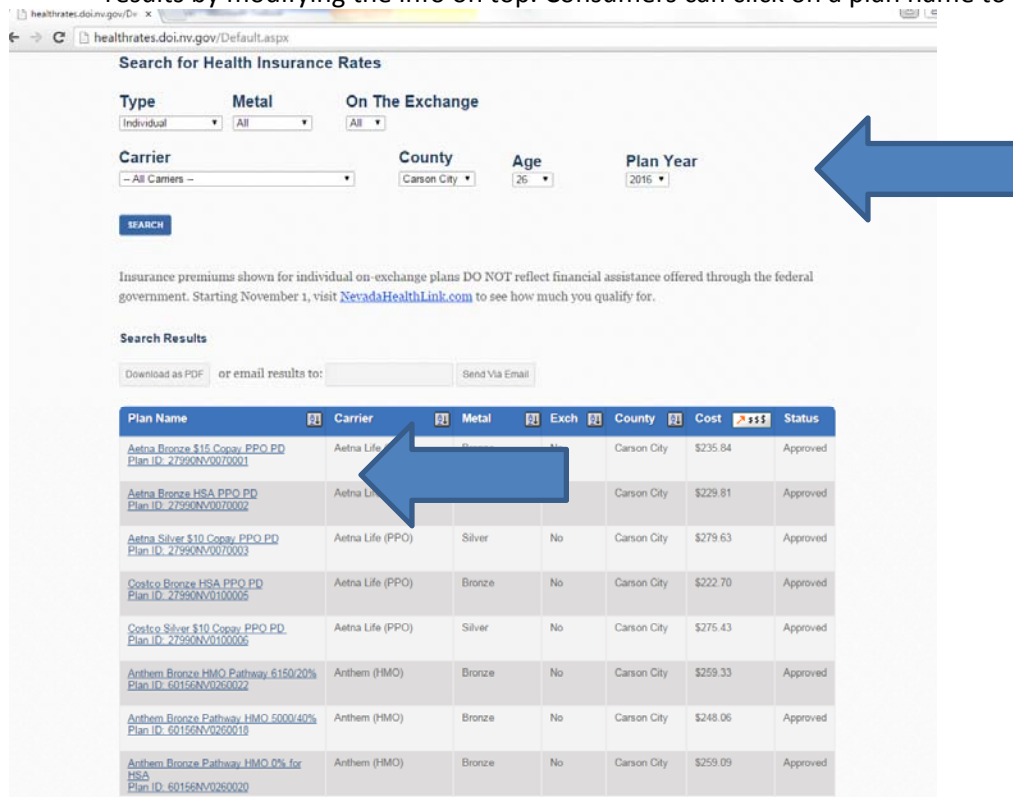
2. Click on “search for health Insurance rates”



- Consumer may additionally sort what metal tier plan they are interested in, whether they would like to see plans on, or off the Exchange or both, and for what year. Consumers don't have to choose any of the following selections if they want to see ALL the plans!



- After they hit view results, the selected plans will be displayed. They can refine the search results by modifying the info on top. Consumers can click on a plan name to view its details.
