More than 250 residents attended Nevada Health Link's midseason open enrollment event

Nevada Health Link invited residents across the Silver State to "get connected" during a free open enrollment event today at Cashman Center. The event attracted more than 250 residents who came for convenient, free healthcare coverage assistance provided by experienced licensed enrollment professionals.

The enrollment period for health insurance began November 1 and continues through Jan. 31, 2017. Consumers who enroll and pay for a 2017 health insurance policy between December 16, 2016, and January 15, 2017, will not have coverage until February 1, 2017. Consumers who enroll between January 16, 2017, and January 31, 2017, which is the end of the open enrollment period, will not have coverage until March 1, 2017. Nevada Health Link will host a closeout event from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Sunday, Jan. 29, 2017 at Cashman Center.

Open Enrollment is also an opportunity for residents who currently have Exchange-based health insurance to shop for new plans that might better fit their circumstances and their families' needs, which could result in a decrease in their average monthly insurance costs. It is recommended that individuals answer a list of pre-screening questions [here](#) to determine qualification for free or reduced medical coverage. Applicants must provide various documents to enroll, including proof of residency, proof of income, valid identification card and proof of U.S. citizenship.
