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Only five days remaining to enroll in Qualified Health Plans for 2019 *Open Enrollment for Nevada Health Link ends midnight, December 15*

WHAT: Consumers have only five days left to enroll in a Qualified Health Plan for 2019. Open Enrollment closes at midnight on Saturday, Dec. 15. [Nevada Health Link](#), the state's health insurance marketplace, encourages all eligible Nevadans statewide to explore their options for Exchange-based health insurance plans before the clock runs out, because no one can afford to be without health insurance, regardless of health, age or life circumstance.

Continuing until Dec. 15, open enrollment is an opportunity for uninsured and underinsured Nevadans to purchase budget-appropriate, quality health insurance. Residents who are currently insured with Exchange-based health plans are also encouraged to shop for new plans that might better fit their circumstances and their families' needs, which could result in a decrease in average monthly insurance costs.

- **input your zipcode on the website's [in-person assister look up tool](#) to find a broker or navigator near you**
- **determine if you're eligible for federal subsidies or tax credits, which can help reduce out-of-pocket costs**
